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RULES AND REGULATIONS for Showmanship

1. Entries due on the day of the show.
2. Mail in pages 1 and 2 of this packet with your entry fees.
3. Entry fees: \$15.
4. Awards
Champion – rosette ribbon. All other placing – Blue 1st Place, Red 2nd Place, White 3rd Place.
A signed IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics is required.
5. Heifers may be up to 3 years of age.
6. All heifers must exhibit a predominance of beef breeding.
7. After all the heifers are registered, they will be classed by age with no more than 6 animals in a class. The top
8. Heifer from each class will compete for Grand Champion. In the class from which the champion comes, the 2nd place animal can compete for Reserve Grand Champion. Grand Champion will be awarded a Rosette Ribbon.
All cattle must be halter broken. All cattle that become unruly and dangerous will be disqualified.
Any evidence of tampering with cattle (such as the use of unapproved drugs) will automatically be disqualified.
9. All animals must be clipped prior to arrival at the fairgrounds, according to good show ring practices. All heifers
10. will be blow and go (shampoo and blow dry) for the show. If you have grooming products on your animal you
11. will not show. NO BATHING FACILITIES ON GROUND
ALL CATTLE ENTREES MUST STAY IN THE AREA DESIGNATED. IF AN ANIMAL LEAVES THEIR DESIGNATED AREA IT WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE SHOW.
All entrees will be released at the end of the show. Please clean up your area before you leave.
12. Exhibitors may show up to 6 animals, not in the same class, but must provide another exhibitor with Ethics # if more than one of their animals qualifies for the championship class.
All exhibitors are to be neatly dressed in jeans, boots, buttoned shirt. No hats or tobacco products are permitted
13. in the show ring.

GENERAL BEEF HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. All Beef must be accompanied by an Official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection dated no earlier than 90 days prior to the date of the fair. Vet Certifications must be in hand and completed when you enter the fairgrounds in April.
The OCVI (Vet Certificate) must be complete including the breed, name and registration number.
2. All vehicles transporting animals for exhibition in Florida shall be cleaned and disinfected prior to the loading of
3. the animal.
Prior to the acceptance at an exhibition, all animals presented for exhibition WILL be visually inspected by a
4. veterinarian licensed in the State of Florida, or by a Department representative for:
 - a. The required identification of the animal.
 - b. Clinical signs of disease.Any animal which has clinical signs of contagious or infectious disease on visual inspection (this includes warts, inspect your animal early on, contact your veterinarian if there is evidence of warts), or any animal known to be
5. exposed must be:
 - a. Withdrawn from exhibition and returned to the place of origin, or
 - b. examined at the owner's expense within 24 hours by a veterinarian licensed in the State of Florida who certifies by a signed written statement that the animal is free of contagious or infectious disease.
