1. Ear # - The number or letters permanently tattooed in your animals left ear.
2. Breed – The recognized breed of rabbit by the American Rabbit Breeders Association or indicate PET if not purebred.
3. Color – The recognized color of rabbit by the American Rabbit Breeders Association.
4. Class – The class of rabbits in the age classification that your rabbit will be judged in. Circle only the correct age:
Jr – rabbit under 6 months of age, 6-8 mos – rabbit between the ages of 6 and 8 months, Sr – rabbit over 6 months of age.
5. Sex – The sex of your rabbit showing – Buck (male) or Doe (female).
6. Make sure you sign your entry.
7. Any entry form not filled out completely and correctly will be returned to you.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entries due the day of the show.
2. Mail in pages 1 and 2 of this packet with your entry fees.
3. Entry fees: \$5 per entry. Each entry must have their own cages.
4. AWARDS:
 - a. Blue, Red and White ribbons will be awarded to recognized purebred breeds and/or varieties, except for ages 5-7, which will receive a green ribbon. Red or White ribbons will be awarded to unrecognized breeds and/or varieties, except for ages 5-7, which will receive a green ribbon. White ribbons will be awarded to all mixed breed entries, except for ages 5-7, which will receive a green ribbon.
 - b. Rosettes will be awarded to the class winners.
 - c. A Grand and Reserve Grand Champion will be selected, based on overall qualities determined by the judge according to ARBA Standards of Perfection.A signed IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics is required.
5. Rabbits may not be placed until approved by the Show Chair or Show Committee. The Rabbit Show Chair may decline any entries he feels should not be shown.
6. Rabbits will not be accepted if they appear unhealthy or infested with lice, mites or fleas. Ears must be clean and free of mites. Nails must be trimmed.
7. It is to your advantage to show only purebred rabbits. Refer to American Rabbit Breeders Association (ARBA)
8. Standard of Perfection. A purebred rabbit will be defined as an animal whose parents are of the same
9. recognized breed and meet the requirements for the standards of their breed as defined in the ARBA Standard of Perfection. A purebred rabbit does not need registration papers or a pedigree. The Pet Rabbit classes are for rabbits with unknown heritage.

No rabbits may be sold on the Fairgrounds, during the Fair.
There will be NO medicating of rabbits. If illness appears during the Fair, the rabbit(s) must be removed from the barn, upon the decision of the rabbit superintendent.
10. Each exhibitor must register their rabbit(s) with the superintendent.
11. Entry forms are to be filled out including all info asked for. Forms filled out incorrectly may be forfeited. Entries will be limited to five rabbits.

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14. A FFA Advisory, 4-H Agent or 4-H Leader signature is required on each form verifying ownership of rabbits and affiliation to 4-H and FFA. Those not affiliated with 4-H or FFA must have signatures of parents verifying residency. Leased or borrowed animals will not be permitted.
15. All rabbits must be owned by the exhibitor 60 days prior to fair entry.
16. PARENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO CHECK IN FOR EXHIBITORS. See Fair schedule for check-in time.
17. Refer to American Rabbit Breeders Association (ARBA) Standard of Perfection. A list of recognized breeds and their standards can be found on the ARBA website www.arba.net. A purebred rabbit will be defined as an animal whose parents are of the same recognized breed and meet the requirements for the standards of their breed as defined in the ARBA Standard of Perfection.
18. Animals may be taken home after the Rabbit Show.
19. No rabbits may be sold on the Fairgrounds during the Fair.
20. The Fair Association will not be responsible for any loss.
21. No doe may be shown pregnant.
22. Exhibitors must provide feed and water containers (for each cage) and feed and water rabbit(s) throughout the event. DO NOT FEED ANIMALS THAT DO NOT BELONG TO YOU. If you see a distressed animal, contact the Rabbit Chair or a member of rabbit committee for assistance.
23. Rabbits may only be removed from cages with permission of the Rabbit Chair or show committee.
24. Failure to abide by these rules will result in the loss of ribbons and future showing privileges.
25. Rabbits will be judged on a Modified Danish System. All participants under age of 8 years will receive a ribbon of participation. All rabbits will be judged individually, except for meat pens, they are judged as a group. Meat pens shall consist of three rabbits, all the same breed and variety. Maximum age limit is 10 weeks. Minimum weight will be 3 pounds each and Maximum weight 5 pounds each.
26. Exhibitor must physically show his/her exhibit during the show, using accepted handling techniques and abiding by minimum Fair official dress of dark pants and white collared shirt.
