Please Read and Sign.

1. This contest is open to all kids who reside in Florida and/or attend school who has reached their 17th birthday but have not reached their 20th birthday.
2. **A contestant cannot qualify for the contest if she/he has ever been married, has a child, or has been found guilty of a felony. Our 2020 Miss/Mr Marion County Queen/King will be required to volunteer throughout the Marion County Fair week and make personal appearances at the various fair events. You will be the face of the 2021 Marion County Fair.**
3. Contestants will be judged on poise, beauty, over-all presentation, and on-station questions.
4. Contests will create a garment out of recyclable materials to be worn by contestant. Materials must be 75 percent used materials (plastic, paper, etc.) with 25 percent new (glue, thread, or material).
5. Contestants are to provide a 1 (one) paragraph long informational speech about themselves that will be read by the emcee while you are on stage walking for the judges. You will also have an on-stage question. ****Please mail or email the paragraph about yourself with your entry form and also bring a copy with you to the pageant for the emcee.**
6. Dresses for the pageant must be formal and must be floor length. No exposed midriff.
7. All contestants must have on appropriate attire to participate.
8. If crowned, you will have the opportunity to ride in the Belleview Christmas Parade in Marion County as a featured guest as part of your prize package. We also would encourage volunteering in your community throughout the year and posting pictures on your queen's/king's page. Take pride in your community while making a difference one crown at a time.
9. The pageant entry fee is \$50.00. Photogenic is \$10.00 extra. Payment can be sent to Marion County Fair Board (make check payable to: FKHK Marion County Fair).
10. An optional photogenic contest can be entered for \$10 per picture or 3 for \$20 and can be signed up and paid for at the door. Don't miss the chance to win a beautiful crown and award.
11. In addition, we are offering a beautiful crown and award to the contestant that donates the most individually wrapped candy (calculated by bag ounces) to be given out by Florida Kids Helping Kids non-profit during the Fair event on. This day is designated Special Needs Day to accommodate kids with Autism or other special needs.
12. Registration begins at 12:00pm and pageant starts at noon. A spectator door entry fee is \$5 and payable at the door.
13. Deadline: March 27, 2020 at 5:00PM.
